1 Statement of Accounting Policies

Reporting Entity

Hamilton Old Boys Cricket Club Inc. is a club. The financial statements of Hamilton Old Boys Cricket Club Inc. are general purpose financial statements which have been prepared according to generally accepted accounting practice in New Zealand.

Statement of Compliance and Basis of Preparation

The accounting principles recognised as appropriate for the measurement and reporting of income and financial position on an historical cost basis are followed by the club.

Specific Accounting Policies

The following specific accounting policies which materially affect the measurement of income and financial position have been applied

(a) Revenue

Revenue is recognised on an accruals basis.

(b) Expenses

Expenses have been classified on their business function.

(c) Trade Receivables

Trade receivables are recognised at estimated realisable value.

(d) Property, Plant and Equipment

Property, Plant and Equipment are recognised at cost less aggregate depreciation. Depreciation has been calculated using the maximum rates permitted by the Income Tax Act 2004. Gains and losses on disposal of fixed assets are taken into account in determining the operating result for the year.

(e) Income Tax

The Club is not subject to income tax pursuant to the Income Tax Act 2004.

(f) Investments

Investments are valued at the lower of cost or market value.

(g) Goods and Services Taxation (GST)

Revenues and expenses have been recognised in the financial statements inclusive of GST.

(h) Changes in Accounting Policies

There have been no changes in accounting policies. All policies have been applied on a basis consistent with those from previous financial statements.
