1. Statement of Accounting Policies

Reporting Entity

Hamilton Old Boys Cricket Club Incorporated is a club.

The financial statements of Hamilton Old Boys Cricket Club Incorporated are general purpose financial statements that have been prepared according to generally accepted accounting practice.

Statement of Compliance and Basis of Preparation

The club follows the accounting principles recognised as appropriate for the measurement and reporting of the financial performance and financial position of an historical basis.

Specific Accounting Policies

- (g) Changes in Accounting Policies There have been no changes in accounting policies. All policies have been applied on a basis consistent with those from previous financial statements.
